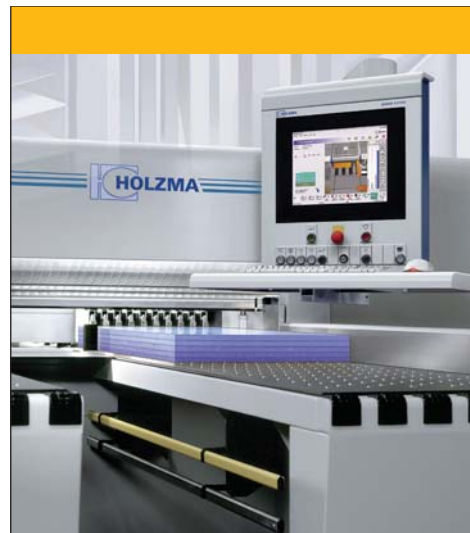
The tournament will be held next year in June. The date is still to be determined.
